Hiking / swimming / nature

Lake of Salagou (A)

The Lac du Salagou is famous for its red earth and cinematic setting that evokes the Great West. It can be reached by car (30 minutes from the estate) or on foot from Mourèze for a panoramic view of the lake (2h20 or 3h20 hike - intermediate level).

The Navacelles circus (B)

The Navacelles circus is a natural circus 1 hour from the estate. It is an "island" carved out of a canyon by the river Vis. You can get there by car or on foot - there's a hike for that. Inside the cirque, you can walk, ride a horse, ride a donkey, ride an electric bike, take the shuttle or take a guided tour.

The Ravin des Arcs (C)

The Ravin des Arcs is a magnificent short hike in the Lamalou Gorges, passing under the natural arch of the Ravin des Arcs. Start from the Masclac bridge over the Lamalou. Duration 3h - 5km - intermediate level.

The village of Saint Guilhem le Désert (most beautiful village in France) (D)

The village, just 30 minutes from the estate, is full of narrow streets where you can still admire Renaissance mullioned windows, geminated bays and Gothic lintels.

The Jardin de Saint Hadrien (E)

The Jardin de Saint Hadrien is one of the most spectacular sites in our region. In this garden, you will move from natural stone to free, fragrant flowers and magnificent water features. The garden is a 10-minute drive from the estate.

Roquebrun (F)

The little village of Roquebrun, also known as "Le petit Nice", offers the perfect place to relax, with its location on the banks of the River Orb and its small beach. Ideal for children! It is 45 minutes from the estate.

The Devil's Bridge and the Hérault Gorges (G)

Around 5 minutes' drive from the superb village of Saint Guilhem le Désert, the Hérault passes under the "Pont du Diable" to form a large basin lined with beaches. It's an ideal place to cool off after visiting the village of St Guilhem or the Clamouse caves. You can also hire canoes on the opposite bank.

<u>Carcassonne (H)</u>

Carcassonne, with its medieval city, is a historic town with a wealth of iconic sites to visit, including the Basilica of Saint-Nazaire and the Limousis cave. It is just 1h15 from the estate.

The three mills of Faugères (!)

Faugères is a hilltop village in the north-west of the Hérault, 30 minutes from the estate. At an altitude of 417 metres, come and discover the 4 mills and their magnificent 360° view of the region.

The Vis waterfall at Saint Laurent le Minier - The mini Niagara Falls of Occitanie (J)

The Vis waterfall is located in Saint Laurent du Minier, 1h15 from Domaine de l'Envolée. The water is clear, transparent and refreshing. Above the main waterfall, there's a small footpath running alongside the river. The site also offers some great walks and mountain bike rides.

<u>Superb natural pools in the Gorges d'Heric (K)</u>

Walks through the various natural pools of the Occitanie region. Departure from Mons, 1 hour from the estate.

Pic Saint Loup (L)

The Pic Saint-Loup is a mountain in the Occitanie region, bordering the communes of Valflaunès and Cazevieille.

Located 55 minutes from the Domaine de l'Envolée, it is one of the most beautiful natural and hiking sites in the region.

It can be reached by car or on foot from Cazevieille (5.46 km).

Sports

Canoeing

Canoeing is the perfect family activity for discovering the wonderful landscapes of the Hérault. The Gorges de l'Hérault, the River Orb and the Vallée des Moulins are all magnificent sites for canoeing.

Climbing

There are plenty of climbing trips available in the region. Here are some of our favourite crags: the Pic de Vissou, the Gorges de l'Hérault and Saint-Jean-de-Buèges.

Canyoning

There are many canyoning sites in the region to discover with friends or family, accessible to all (Canyon du Diable, Canyon du Grand Rec, Ravin des Arcs)!



Mediterranean beaches

Cap d'Agde - 25 km away (25 min)

Europe's most famous naturist resort boasts just a handful of naturist beaches. Otherwise, there are more than 10 different beaches, some of the most beautiful fine sandy beaches in the region, long and very wide, each with its own atmosphere. Of these, the beaches of Richelieu and Grande Conque are considered by many to be the best. The beach at Le Môle is perfect for children.

<u>Portiragnes - 27 km away (28 min)</u>

Portiragnes has a lovely sandy beach and hardly any shops. Head west for a better experience but don't expect to find many facilities. Dogs allowed.

<u>Marseillan plage - 30 km away (33 min)</u>

You'll find a small stretch of beach in this pretty, picturesque village. There's also a children's play area, a skate park, a water-ski zip line, kite-surfing lessons and a snack bar. There are plenty of restaurants along the harbour for all-day dining.

<u>Valras - 28 km away (32 min)</u>

To the west of Sérignan, Valras is a typical seaside resort with lots of restaurants and shops. There's a play area on the sand, a children's club and the harbour for a stroll. The beach itself is 4km long and offers many water-based leisure activities. A very safe beach for swimming.

Leucate - 84 km away (55 min)

Leucate plage is a lovely surprise, reminiscent of Australian coastal towns - with houses built on a pine-covered hill. There are two beaches: the main one just opposite, and a much smaller beach, accessible by climbing the rocks, often frequented by naturist bathers.

Pézénas - 6 km away (10 min)

Pézenas is a small town where you'll find plenty of flea markets and antique shops. Its historic centre, made up of narrow streets, is perfect for a family stroll.

Cap d'Agde - 25 km away (25 min)

Situated on the Hérault coast, its port and shops are great for a stroll, and its beaches, such as La Grande Conque, are ideal for swimming.

Béziers - 20 km away (25 min)

Béziers, France's oldest city, is full of colour, ideal for a spot of shopping or a stroll through its many parks, such as the Plateau des Poètes.

Collioure - 150 km away (1h30)

Situated 1 hour and a half from the estate, in terms of history and culture, the town is in the Roussillon region, a former province of the kingdom of France, which existed from 1659 until 1790. This town of colourful buildings will dazzle you with its setting, which combines the Mediterranean Sea with the mountains.

<u>Sète - 45 km away (40 min)</u>

Sète is first and foremost a port. A fishing port in the centre and a commercial and passenger port to the east, its landscape is punctuated by cranes, boats ranging from the smallest to the largest, warehouses and docks. Sète is a little jewel between sea and lake.
